






2020 Year-End Financial Performance

- 2020 in Review: A challenging year financially
 - NAEM ended FY2020 with 1/3 less in revenue than the prior year
 - Experienced a 50% reduction of revenue from association conferences
 - Dues revenue was down 15% from 2019
 - Cost cutting measures reduced expenses by \$1.1 million
 - Net cash losses of almost \$400K
 - NAEM took a line of credit for \$250K to preserve cash on hand




NAEM Financials: Revenue by Source 2020 Summary




